Distinction in Pakistan

Last year there were eight students who appeared for French IGCSE exam, there was one student who was awarded a distinction in Pakistan.

In June 2015, one student got a distinction in Punjab for IGCSE History.

Chinese Mandarin IGCSE exam - June 2015

ISC-Lahore's two students were the first ever in Pakistan to sit for IGCSE exam in Chinese Mandarin in 2015, both scored A grade.

YCT (Youth Chinese Test)

The Youth Chinese Test (YCT) is an international standardized Chinese language test which is directed at examining non-native, primary and secondary school students. Last year there were six students from ISC-Lahore who achieved A grade.

DEL F (Diplome d'e'tudes en langue Francaise)

DEL F is a certification of the French Language skills for non-native speakers of French administered by the International Centre for French Studies.

- In Delf A1 Junior there were eight students who appeared from ISC-Lahore, all of them scored A grade; there were four students who got a distinction in Pakistan.
- In Delf A2 there were four students who appeared for the exam and three scored As; whereas two of them came in 1st and 3rd position in Pakistan.
- In Delf B2 exam one student got 2nd position in Pakistan.

SAT scores (Scholastic Assessment Test)

Every year our students give SAT exams. Last year three students scored above 2200 out of 2400. We are really proud of them!

PSAT and PSAT 10

PSAT examination allows students to test their academic ability and skills by taking the test and receiving an analysis of their results, so that they can improve before taking more demanding examinations later on, such as SAT and AP, as well as to increase their readiness for college and university.

For the last three years our students have given PSAT and PSAT 10 exams and have been consistently achieving good scores.

AP COLLEGE BOARD (May 2016)

Advanced Placement examinations are taken every May by our students at participating American, Canadian, and international educational institutions. The tests are the culmination of year-long **AP** courses. Every year we get excellent scores in AP exams.

The AP Program recognizes high school students who have demonstrated outstanding college-level achievement through AP courses and exams with the AP Scholar Awards, AP Scholars with Honors and AP Scholars with Distinction.

Last year, out of the graduating class, five students were awarded the award of AP Scholar, five students qualified with the AP Scholar with Honors and eight students obtained the award of the AP Scholars with Distinction.
